Good morning to you, from Rosary Church in Chatham Rd, Tsimsha  
 The Mass for today will be beginning in a few moments now, <sup>tsui</sup>  
 when the celebratn and assistants arrive to the altar. We'd  
 like especially to welcome to join us in spirit here those of  
 you who are sick today and can't join with your fellow-Xtians  
 in community prayer, worship and celebration before God on  
 this Day of the Lord. Today is the 30th ordinary Sunday of the  
 year; and the scripture readings for today continue a general  
 theme we've been having in recent Sunday readings, on prayer:  
 St Luke's gospel, a kind of parallel O.T. passage from the Bk

 Timothy. But now the Mass begins, with a rite of prayer,  
 repentance and praise to God.
