22nd Sunday of Year

Good morning to you, from the church of the Holy Rosary, the parish church of the Tsimshtsul district : in a few moments the Mass for today, the 22nd ordinary Sunday of the year, will be beginning here ; and we'd like to welcome you listening to your radio to join with the people gathered here now, join in spirit and in prayer for this hour or so, to give glory and praise to God this (hot/lovely) summer Sunday morning. It's a time to give thanks : but that, as the scripture readings of today remind us, requires us to be honestly aware that we do receive so much... The O.Testament reading (from the Bk of Ecclesiasticus, or Ben Sirach) is a pre-echo of the gospel of St Luke where Jesus warns that elbowing one's way to the top, making oneself important, is not the way to enter into the kingdom. Those readings come in the first part of our service of worship : before that, though, we begin with a rite of prayer and repentance, acknowledging our need to be healed by God's forgiveness and grace. The Mass begins as the priest and assistants enter the sanctuary of the church and an Entrance hymn is sung.
