Readings**Creed**

Offert.: The first part of the Easter Mass now over, the Reading of Scripture and the prayers, the celebrant now goes to the altar and begins the preparation for the Liturgy of the Eucharist, while the gifts of bread and wine are brought up to the altar.

Preface**Pater**

Communion: At the altar, the celebrant now receives Christ in the Easter communion; and people in the congregation who wish to share this Easter Eucharist are now approaching the altar-rails. During the giving of holy communion, the choir will sing; and you may like to reflect also on this Eastertime communion, in your own personal prayer, or in the words of some old Easter prayers of the Church and of the Saints: **Q Q Q**

After the giving of Holy Communion, the priest returns to the altar and places in the tabernacle the consecrated hosts that are left over; and then he cleans briefly the chalice and patens that have been used during the Mass. After a few moments silent prayer, he then recites the Thanksgiving Prayer of Easter Sunday and gives the Blessing ~~and Dismissal~~

END: After the Blessing and Dismissal, the celebrant and the assistants leave the altar in procession to return to the sacristy. And as a recessional hymn is sung and people begin to leave the church, we come to the end of this broadcast of the Easter Day Mass which you've been listening to from the parish church of St Anthony in Pokfulam Road.
