There is no mention in the Gospels of the risen Jesus greeting His Mother: but that's a scene that's been imagined by saints and mystics, knowing and understanding that it must have taken place. The Book of Marjory Kempe, an early 15th century English mystic, places that scene right before Jesus' appearance to Mary Magdalene in the garden where the tomb was: in Marjory Kempe's vision, Jesus asks leave of His Mother to go speak with Mary Magdalene. Here is Marjory Kempe's account of her vision, what she saw & heard, as she waited in prayer-contemplation with the Mother of Jesus on Easter morning: BB.
