It's one of a number of churches in England (and elsewhere) dedicated to St Clement who was one of the very first bishops of Rome, the third after St Peter in fact. And one of the oldest and loveliest churches in Rome is San Clemente too. Well, <sup>his festival</sup> today, the 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov, is his feast day. There's not very much known about him for fact, tho' there's a lot of legend. But he did write a famous letter to the Christians of Corinth, which I want to quote a bit from for you today. But first a little about the man: he died about 100 AD, and St Irenaeus says that
