

Trails for Early Music: Lent & Easter

Series intro.....

MUSIC: Chant -- 'Attende Domine' 97R23 tr 3

KANE: 'Early Music' on the Sundays of March will be featuring music for the Christian church season of Lent and for Easter. It's mostly vocal-music, of course; a lot of polyphony but also chant, cantata, madrigal, solo-voice, 'historia' and passion, and one of the 'mystery sonatas' of Heinrich von Biber: Sunday mornings, 10 to 11, on Radio 4

Sunday 6th March:

MUSIC: Telemann -- He who accepts..... 98R22 tr 10

KANE: From a cantata for 'Laetare' Sunday, the 4th Sunday in Lent, by George Philipp Telemann, featuring in this coming Sunday's 'Early Music' programme: there's also part of Pergolesi's famous "Stabat Mater", and the even more famous Allegri "Miserere" ---- that and more (as they say) on Sunday morning, 10 to 11, Radio 4

Sunday 13th March:

MUSIC: Gesualdo --- O Vos Omnes 94R03 tr 5

KANE: Unaccompanied vocal music *only*, in this week's "Early Music" programme on Sunday morning..... music connected with Lent and Holy Week, by 7 different composers, 4 of them English, 2 Italian, and the 'international' Orlando di Lasso represented by three sections from his "Tears of St Peter". Early Music, Radio 4 on Sunday 10 to 11 a.m.

MUSIC: same to end.

Sunday 20th March:

MUSIC: Vivaldi --- Filiae maestae Jerusalem 98R05 tr 18

KANE: Early Music this Sunday morning has *this* Vivaldi motet, Palestrina's version of "Stabat Mater", an anthem by Michael Wise on words from Lamentations, some of Zelenka's setting of the same Lamentations for the Holy Week Office of Tenebrae, and a medieval 'Lauda' about Christ on His cross: music for Holy Week, Sunday, 10 to 11 a.m., radio 4

Sunday 27th March:

MUSIC: Telemann --- Der Tod ist verschlungen 98R22 tr 17 (19?)

KANE: Trumpets for Easter Day, from one of Telemann's cantatas; from a mystery *play* for Easter Day; a mystery sonata, 'The Resurrection'; from an Easter 'historia'; an Easter plainchant Sequence hymn; and a couple of Easter-day motets --- that's Early Music for Easter, on Sunday morning, radio 4, 10 o'clock
